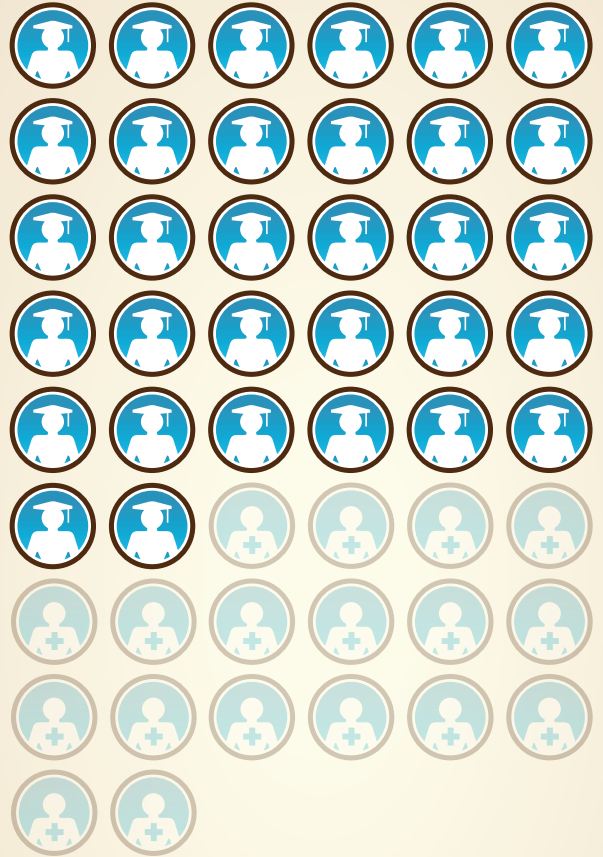

Equal to approximately 20,000 graduates or unfilled allied health positions

In 2010-2020, the state will only have the capacity to educate **297,000 allied health workers**, shutting Californians out of **145,000 family-sustaining jobs**.

By 2030, California's education capacity will almost double to produce **634,000 allied health workers**, but it will still need to train **375,000 more** to meet the state's needs.
